#### Maps



Free parking is available in designated ACROD bays for holders of current ACROD permits.








### Walk from the Pi1 carpark to the venue

Registrations & networking will take place in B210.103.


Directional 'Research Rumble' signs will be placed on the outside of the venue.




Main entrance

Networking space






#### Lecture theatre

Latecomers will be escorted to the rear entrance.




Main entrance to lecture theatre

Rear entrance






#### **Toilets**

Please feel free to visit the space or see Event staff who will be able to assist.






# Universally Accessible Route
