You can use [Transperth](#) to plan your journey.

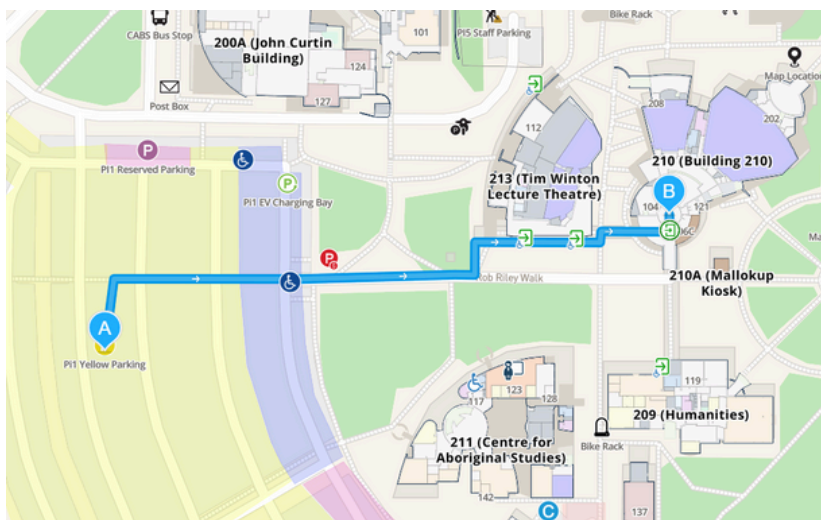


Parking

Parking is available nearby to the venue in [Pi1 yellow carpark](#) and is free after 4:30pm.

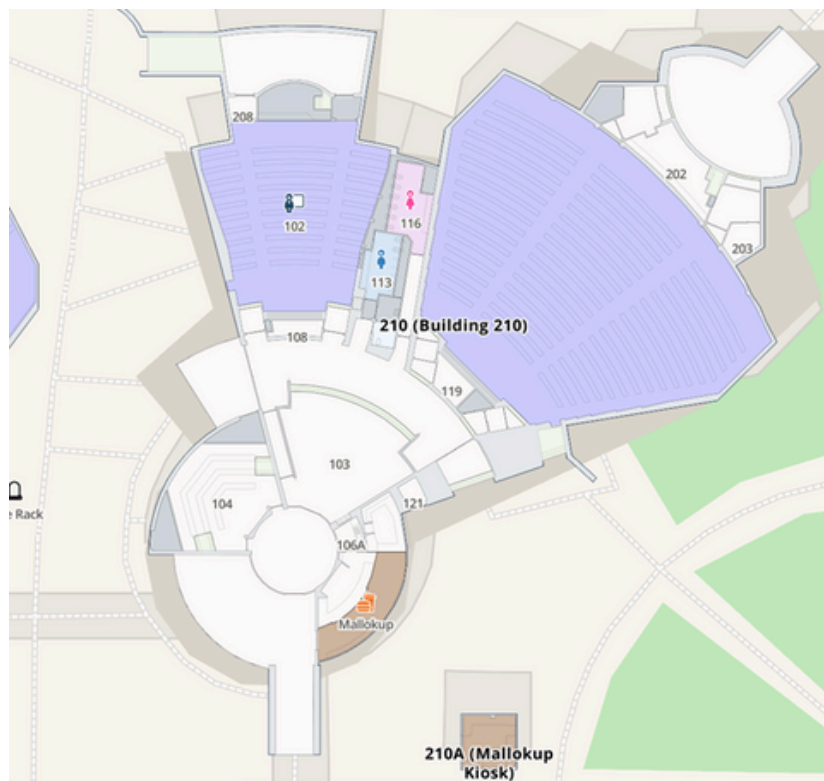
Free parking is available in designated ACROD bays for holders of current ACROD permits.

Registration & networking

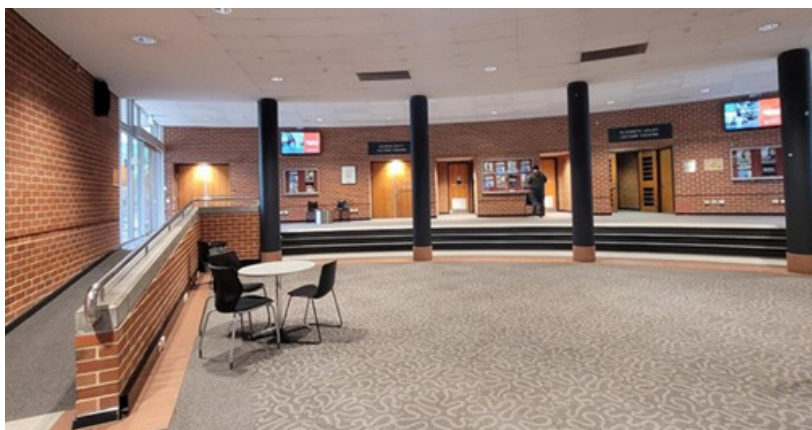
Directional 'Research Rumble' signs will be placed on the outside of the venue.

Lecture Theatre: The lecture theatre is tiered but features a flat section to accommodate wheelchairs.

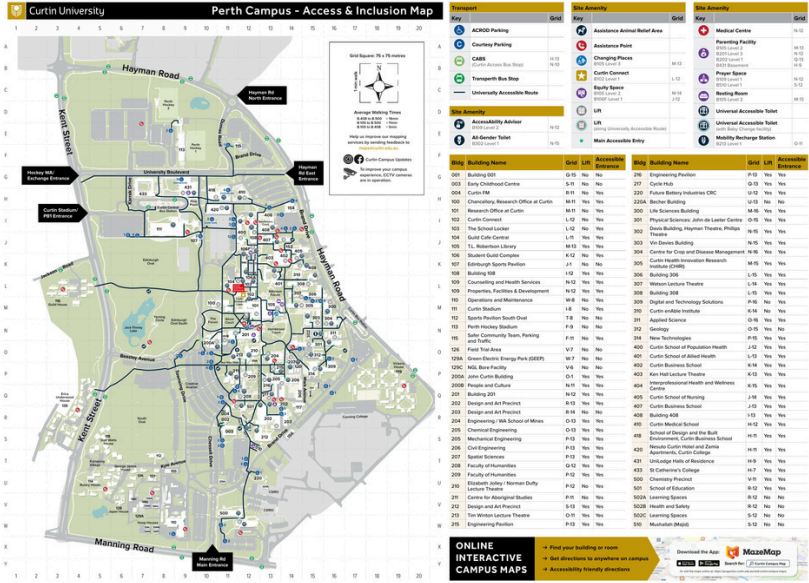
