You can use [Transperth](#) to plan your journey.

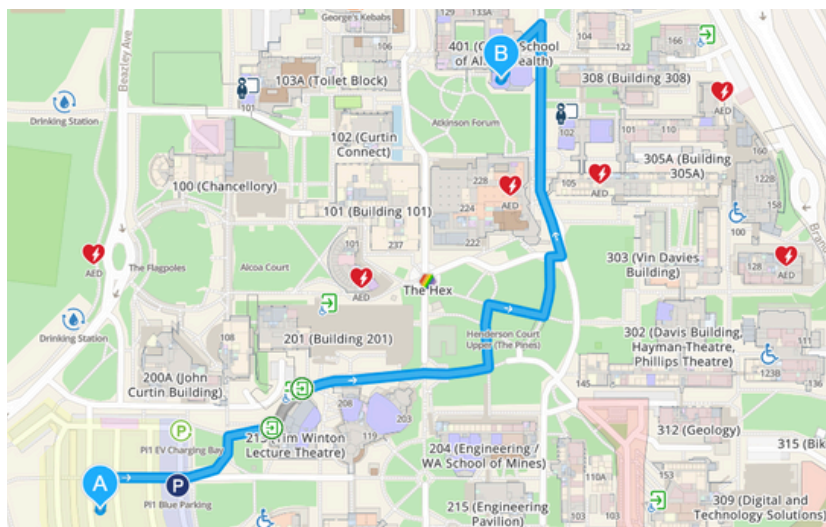


Parking

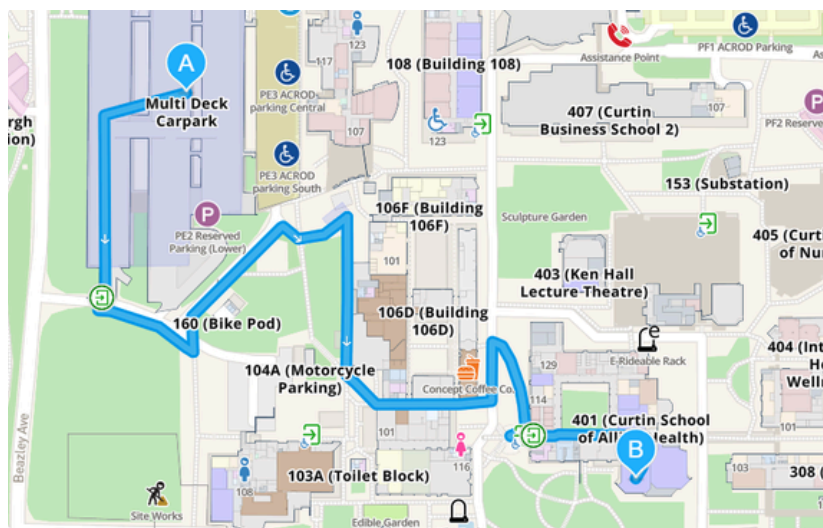
Parking is available nearby to the venue in [Pi1 yellow carpark](#) and the [multi deck carpark](#).

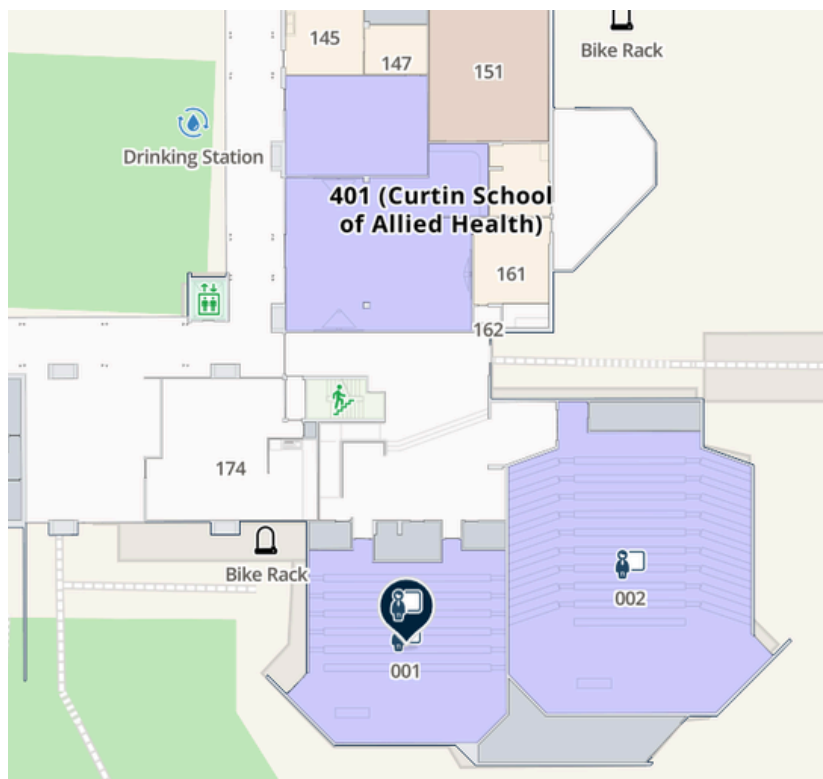


From the multi deck carpark, follow the accessible route to the venue

Venue entrance and registration

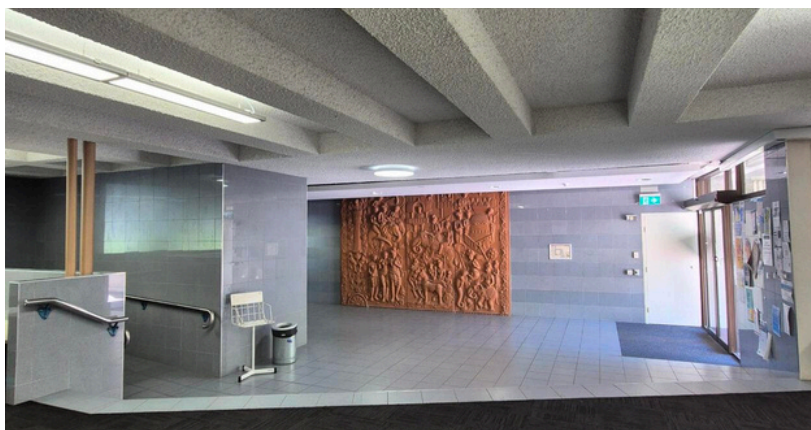
Directional 'Research Rumble' signs will be placed on the outside of the venue.

Entrance to Hollis Theatre

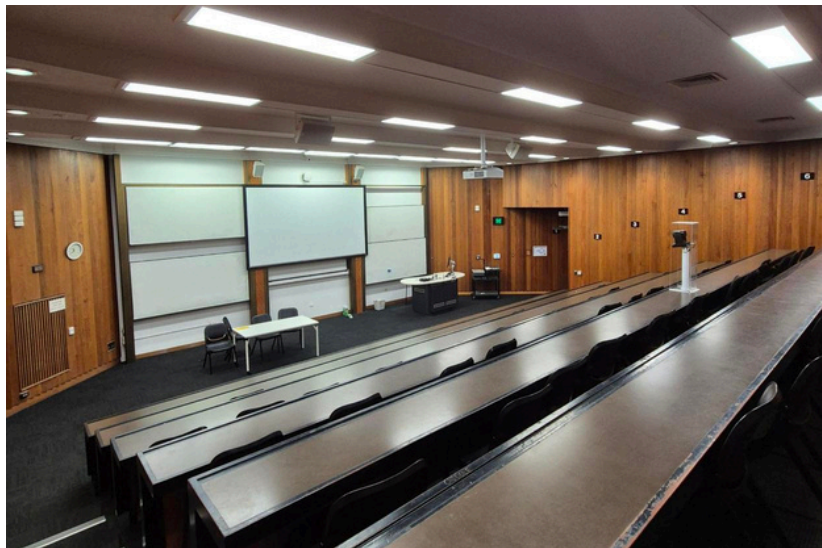


Foyer of Hollis Theatre

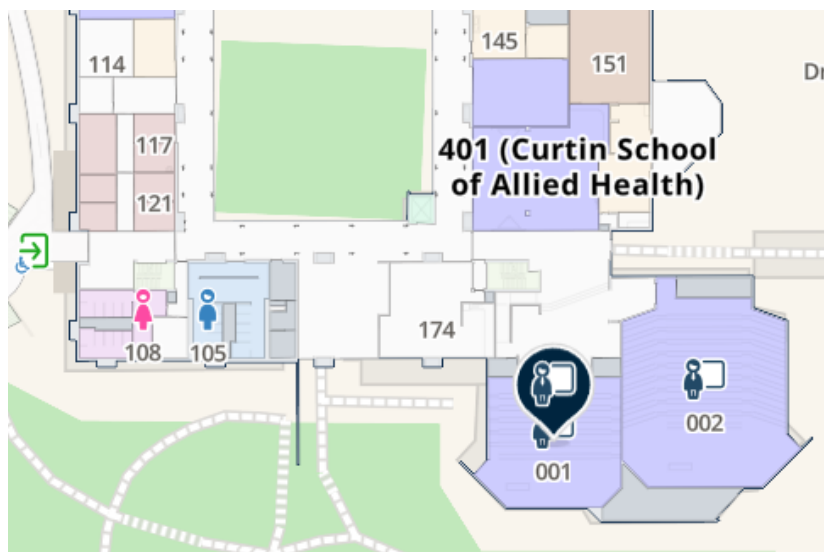
Formal proceedings will take place in the Hollis I Lecture Theatre, Building 401.001.

Lecture Theatre: The lecture theatre is tiered but features a flat section to accommodate wheelchairs.

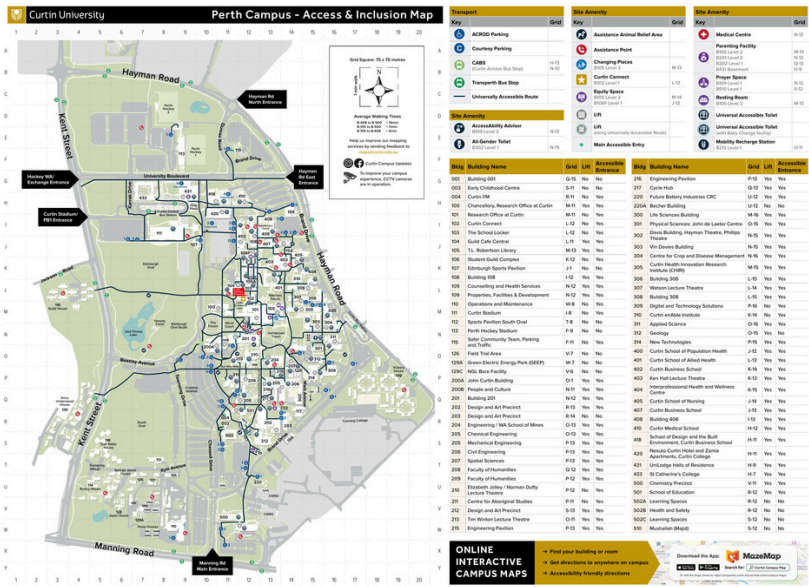
